Officer Merritt Updates:

Snell Isle had multiple incidents last month, including 12 auto burglaries and residential burglaries, etc. Police did make a couple of arrests.

Crescent Heights incidents over 2 months:

1 auto burglary.

Incident of man with gun at laundry who had an expired concealed weapon permit from Georgia.

Strong arm robbery at Papa Johns related to marijuana (no guns involved).

Police made 6 one hour neighborhood walks this month.

14 directed patrols of extra units to deter auto burglaries.

Discussion about people running stop signs in our neighborhood.

We will be purchasing plaques to put on murals recognizing CHNA. Applause for Thomas Paterek. He answered questions about the murals. The 3 birds (blue jays, cardinals and mocking birds) were chosen because prevalent in our neighborhood. The historic mural was also explained.
